The STRUCTURED Prayer Pathway is marked by establishing an ordered life of prayer through a commitment to set times and consistent practices that draw upon both scriptural and time honored historical/liturgical methods/approaches of prayer.

Examples: Daniel, David & the Apostles

The CONTEMPLATIVE Prayer Pathway is marked by waiting and listening in God's presence in silence while centering one's attention fully upon Him.

Examples: Abraham & Isaac, Hannah, Mary the mother of Jesus, Anna & Simeon

The SPONTANEOUS Prayer Pathway is marked by a predominately ongoing responsiveness to the Holy Spirit throughout the day and informal conversation with God free from formulaic or ritualized approaches to prayer.

Examples: Elijah, Nehemiah & Steven

The INTERCESSORY Prayer Pathway is marked by maintaining daily intercession times to pray for God's will to be enacted in the earth and to be initiated and directed by the Holy Spirit utilizing prophetic proclamation and spiritual warfare.

Examples: Moses, Samuel, the Prophets Isaiah, Ezekiel, Jeremiah, & the Apostle Paul
